## COURSE OUTLINE

Specifically tailored for current and aspiring professional Paramedics, the Ambulance Technical, Operation, and Defensive Driving course will introduce the participant to technical features and engineered safety of today's modern ambulance. The knowledge and skills learned in this program is not taught in the college curriculum. During the course the participant will spend time in classroom, in vehicle, and on the road one-on-one with the Training Officer.

Course materials include participant workbook featuring content organized for progressive learning, skills summary, charts and diagrams, and self study content.
